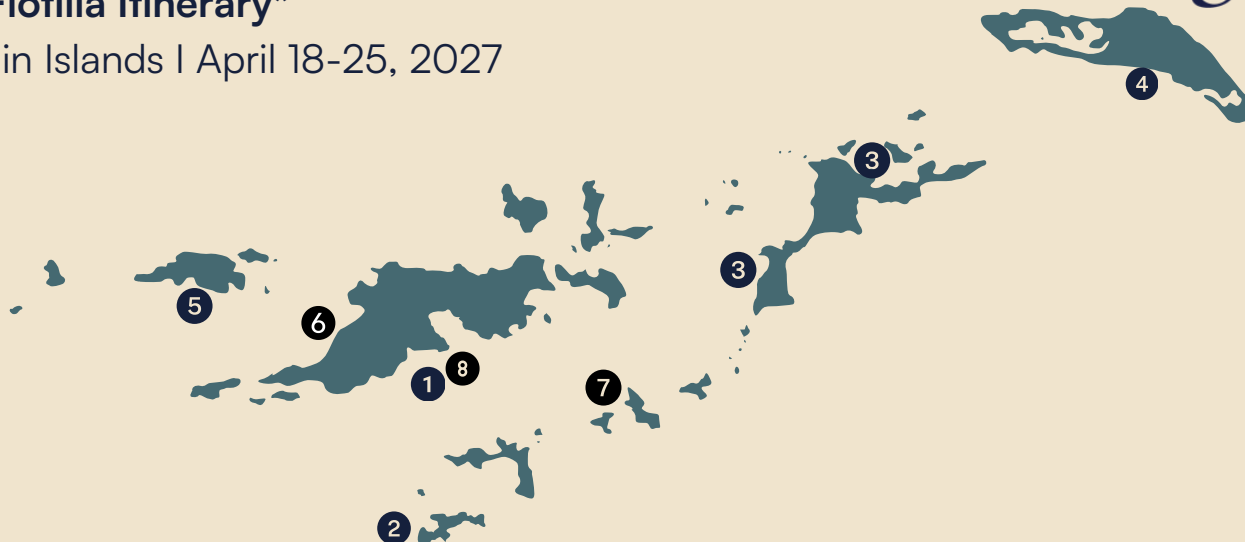


BoatU.S. Flotilla Itinerary*

<p>1</p>	<p>Sunday, April 18 - Arrive at marina, get settled on your boat, do your chart and boat briefing, and take care of any provisioning needs. Welcome cocktail 8:30PM at the Restaurant Pool Bar.</p>	<p>5</p>	<p>Thursday, April 22 - Cruise to Jost Van Dyke. Visit White Bay's famous beach bars, like Soggy Dollar and Hendo's. Overnight at Great Harbour where you can dine and party at Foxy's.</p>
<p>2</p>	<p>Monday, April 19 - Fleet to embark in the morning after captain's briefings. Cruise to Norman Island. Snorkeling at The Indians and/or The Caves. You can enjoy lunch and a drink at Willy T and visit Pirates Bight for dinner.</p>	<p>6</p>	<p>Friday, April 23 - Head to Sandy Cay to enjoy breakfast with a view or a quick snorkel session in the area before cruising south to Cane Garden Bay. This location can be great for watersports and offers plenty of bars and restaurants ashore.</p>
<p>3</p>	<p>Tuesday, April 20 - Early morning departure to visit The Baths. Depart after lunch to head to the North Sound, Virgin Gorda. Overnight at Leverick Bay, Dinner & Entertainment provided by The Moorings.</p>	<p>7</p>	<p>Saturday, April 24 - Set sail around the West End of Tortola to Cooper Island. This eco-resort has a wonderful bar, its own brewery, a boutique for last-minute gift shopping, and a restaurant. Snorkeling options are available nearby.</p>
<p>4</p>	<p>Wednesday, April 21 - Morning departure to Anegada. Book a local tour or take a taxi or jeep to explore the island. We recommend having a lobster dinner at Potter's By The Sea in the evening.</p>	<p>8</p>	<p>Sunday, April 25 - After breakfast, return to the marina on Tortola to disembark by 10:00AM. (Optional: Return to the marina in the late afternoon of April 24, if you have an early flight or ferry to catch.)</p>
